

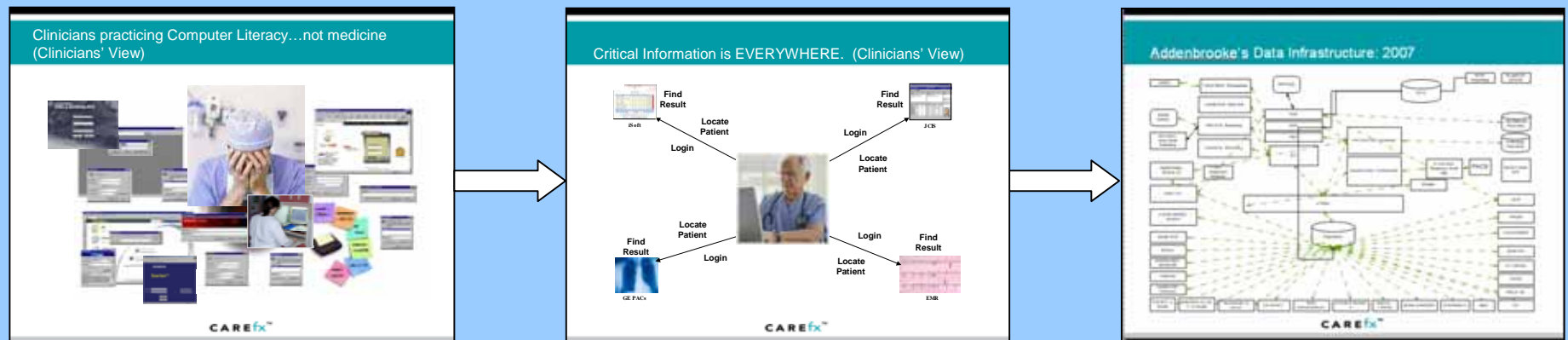
Single Sign On
