Hearing aid accessories

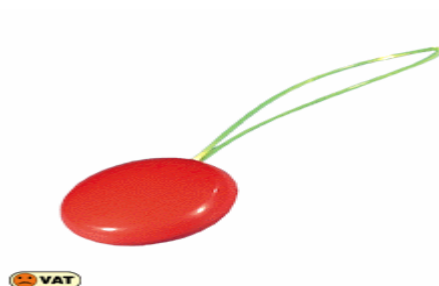
Earmould Puffer

Useful for drying out condensation in the earmould and attached tubing.



Tubing Threader

Allows anyone to rethread the tubing in an earmould.



Drying Kits

Because hearing aids are worn on the body, they absorb moisture internally which can sometimes cause damage to the hearing aids.

Drying out the hearing aids overnight will improve their reliability and help extend their life.

Drying kits are also suitable for keeping earmoulds and tubing dry.
