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Occupational Therapy Services

Hand therapy

Why have you been referred to Occupational Therapy?

You may have recently sustained a hand injury or had surgery to your hand. Alternatively, you may have been born with, or acquired a condition which is affecting the function of your hand.

What can you expect in Occupational Therapy?

Occupational Therapy aims to help you re-establish the maximum possible movement, strength and function in your hand. This is achieved through the use of specific exercises and everyday activities.

On referral to Occupational Therapy, you will either be seen on the same day or an appointment will be made at a time which is convenient to both yourself and your Therapist.

To begin with, an assessment of your hand condition will be carried out and the Occupational Therapist will plan a treatment programme which will be discussed with you.

Treatment may involve a department-based programme or specific exercises, which you can carry out at home. The Occupational Therapist may also advise you on making things easier with everyday activities, such as work, driving, leisure pursuits, and can recommend special equipment to help you. Occupational therapy varies in length and frequency – this will be discussed with you as part of your assessment.

Where is Occupational Therapy?

Occupational therapy is located on level one of outpatients.
