

Remembrance Books in the Chapel

Two oak cabinets in the chapel each contain a Book of Remembrance. One recalls members of the Hospital Staff who have died; the other babies who were cared for in The Rosie Maternity Hospital, and whose short, but precious, lives are affectionately recorded.

The Remembrance Books are turned daily to display the correct date. If however, you wish to see a special date, keys are kept in the Chaplaincy Office and at Addenbrooke's main reception.
